Concept Note:

The educational arena is in the throes of constant change and educators need to update their teaching skills in order to continue being relevant. The English Language teaching fraternity also needs to upgrade and update themselves in order to communicate with the new generation learners in a language they understand. Pedagogy has been revolutionised by the Web and has affected learners, learning material, teachers, teaching material, learning strategies, stakeholders, policy makers and the list goes on. In order to teach English to Generation Z and to prepare them for a future that is yet to take shape, the English teachers must equip themselves with contemporary digital tools and techniques of teaching and assessment. Such a gaping disconnect can be checked and communication re-established by familiarizing the teachers with new era web tools. This National Level Faculty Development Workshop attempts to bring all English teachers under a common platform for training, and sharing modern methods of teaching English especially among second language learners. It will enable participating teachers to:

- Set up discussion forums for engaging learners and creating new vistas of teaching and learning through technology
- Conduct formative digital assessment modes to help learners check their learning
- Have a better understanding of the available ICT tools for teaching learning English
- Take-home ideas for using technology in classrooms
- Provide training Manuals on Web 2.0 Tools
- Build network of teachers interested in educational technology
