ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

Teaching methods and approaches are the commonest solutions to the search of most effective ways of teaching second or foreign language so far. However, the discontent with the inadequacies of methods resulted in a movement in the form of Post-method pedagogy (PMP) from the late 19th century to the late 20th century. Stern (1983; 1992) came up with the three dimensional framework and Kumaravadivelu presented a three-dimensional system consisting of three pedagogic parameters: particularity, practicality, and possibility based on macro-strategic framework drawn from theoretical, empirical and experiential knowledge, which is the most detailed and authoritative framework to date. Brown (1994a; 2002) too has given a post-method framework with a total of twelve principles divided into cognitive, affective and linguistic domains. It should be a matter of prime concern for any institute dealing with teacher education to keep researching to update and equip the teacher educators as well as the prospective teachers and make them 'transformative intellectuals' Kumaravadivelu (2003). Hence, this national conference is looking forward to assure the above said concern and facilitate the delegates with an opportunity to achieve higher understanding and clearer vision that may help them create better teacher, better society and better humans!
